


Kanopy Instructions


Stream Classic Cinema, Indie Films and Top Documentaries to Your Device or TV

Go to the Monroe Township Library homepage at www.monroetwplibrary.org. Click the pink rectangle that says "Films – Kanopy Streaming Movies."


Or, go directly to http://monroetw.kanopy.com.




Select Add A Library Card to create a new account. Existing users should select Log In.




Enter your 14-digit Monroe Township Library card number. Then, click **Continue**.



Fill out the account information, including First Name, Last Name, Email Address and Password. Click on **Sign Up** to finish creating your account.



Once logged in, **Browse** by genre or **Search** by keyword for film titles in the menu bar at the top-left side of the page.



- Each card holder is allotted 30 tickets per month. Enjoy unlimited ticket-free plays on Kanopy Kids.
- > Tickets are reset on the first of each month.
- Details about each title, including how many tickets a title will use and how long a user has access to watch it, will be viewable before pressing play.
- > See remaining time for in-progress films by selecting My Lists > Continue Watching.
- Films can be streamed from any computer, television, mobile device or platform by downloading the Kanopy app for iOS, Android, AppleTV, Chromecast or Roku.

Please note: You will need an internet connection to watch films on Kanopy. Films cannot be downloaded to your device. Kanopy's video player automatically adjusts the video quality based on the strength of your internet connection. This will minimize interruptions in playback. It is recommended to stream films over a Wi-Fi connection to avoid using a lot of mobile data.
