



Weather Policy

The Monroe Township Farmers Market will take place *rain or shine*. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Farmers Market may be delayed or cancelled.

Adverse Weather Conditions

If a thunderstorm, tornado warning, tornado watch, heat advisory, or severe and consistent rain occurs **prior to the opening of the Market** and may persist through the Market hours, the Market may be delayed or cancelled altogether. The Market Team will make this decision by 11:30 a.m. on the Market day.

If severe weather conditions develop **after the Market has opened**, customers, vendors and volunteers are expected to move to a safe place until the weather has passed. In most cases the safest place will be in the Library or in their vehicles. Once the weather has passed, the Market Team will determine whether to resume normal Market operations for the remainder of the Market day.

Communication

If the Market Team decides to close or delay the Market, the Market Manager will notify vendors via text or email.
