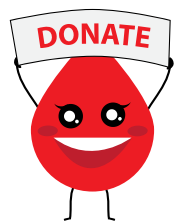
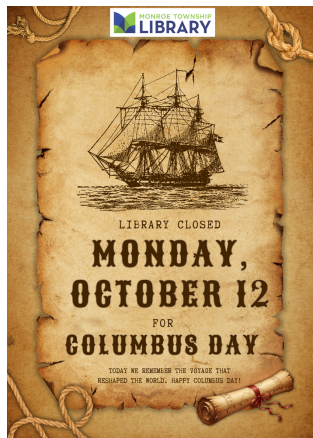
As part of Monroe Township's solar panel project, the Library will be closed on Friday, October 2 so that necessary electrical work can be completed.

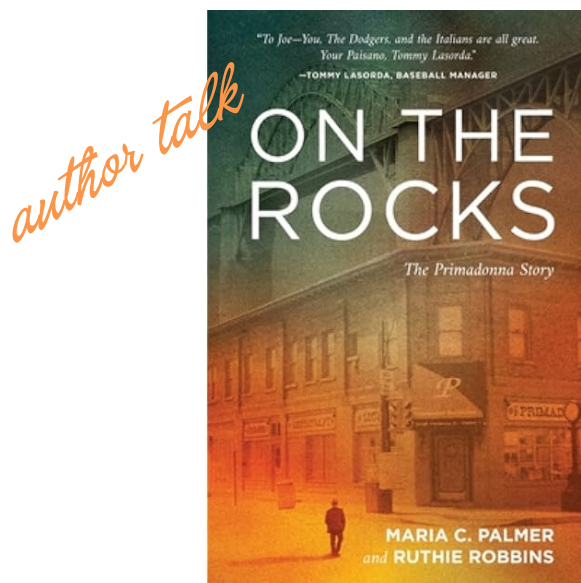

Original quilt designs/wall hangings by Monroe resident Brenda LaDuke will be on display in the Fine Arts Gallery through October 2026.

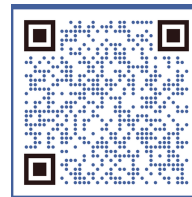
